

Mauro MANTOVANI, born 1966 in Moncalieri (Torino – Italy), is actually President of the Pontifical Salesian University (UPS), Rome, where He is Professor in Theoretical Philosophy. Since November 2016 He is also President of the Conference of Rectors of the Pontifical Roman Universities (CRUPR).

PhD in Salamanca (Spain) in 2006, and in 2010 Doctor in Theology in the Pontifical University “Tommaso d’Aquino” Angelicum, Rome, his investigations and publications focus on Philosophy of God and the philosophical question of God’s existence especially in the history of Thomism and in the academic commentaries to the *Summa Theologiae* by the “School of Salamanca”. Other fields of research are also philosophy of history and the relationship science/faith. Director of the STOQ Project (*Science, Theology and the Ontological Quest*) at UPS, He is Ordinary Member of the Pontifical Academy Saint Thomas Aquinas (PAST) and VicePresident of S.I.T.A.
